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Welcome to the Hajveri Institute.

Approximately 23 years ago we realised that a huge generation of young Muslims, male and female had graduated from the system of education in Masjids all over Europe, but that education did not equip them with the necessary knowledge and understanding of Deen to implement in their modern lives. The net result of this was that this generation who we call the 'lost generation' have emerged with a very basic understanding of Deen, and the ability to simply recite the Arabic of the Qur'an without understanding it.

To further add to the conundrum most Muslims are either almost compelled to adopt a secular lifestyle where Deen is not required; that secular lifestyle is more intellectually appealing to them, and of course appealing to their ego or alternatively they are increasingly becoming embroiled in other sectarian thinking, contrary to the thinking of the Ahle Sunnat Wal Jama'at.

Those that are holding onto the traditional thinking are following what has been taught by their parents in a repetitive manner without realising its real purpose. We realised that this deficit meant that the 'lost generation' had very little to pass on to their next generation other than simply the identity that they were born Muslims.

Having taught our syllabus locally for the last two decades, Hajveri Institute was born in 2022 with a view to expanding our reach to Masjids all over the UK and Europe to empower the Masjid with proper utilisation of Islamic Sciences. Our syllabus is aimed at those who have limited time but wish to empower themselves to become the Scholars of today and tomorrow.

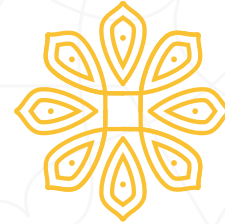

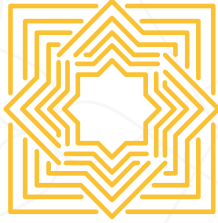

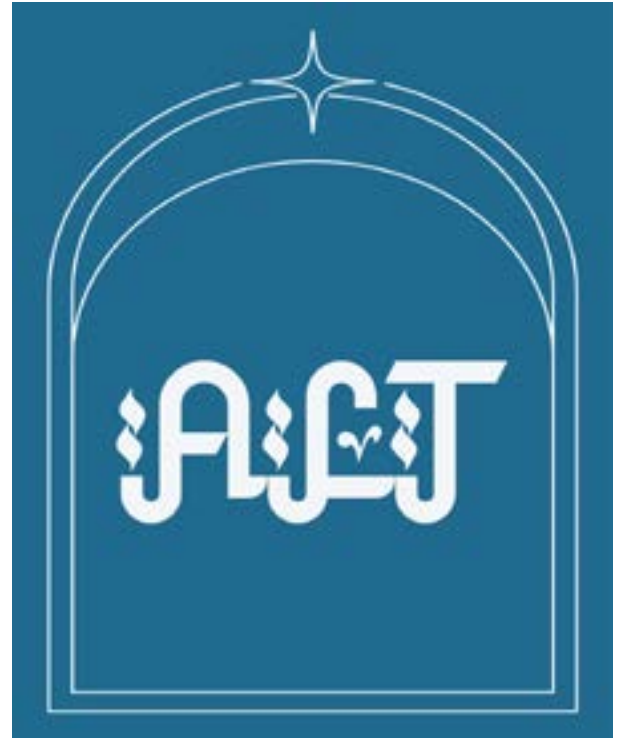
